The Centre Furnace Mansion Reservation Information

Thank you for your interest in the Centre Furnace Mansion for your event venue. The historic Mansion and Furnace Stack are on the National Register of Historic Places, thus provide a unique backdrop for any special event. The Mansion and Grounds are most suitable for smaller [up to 100 person] events. Please find basic information below. More detailed information is available upon request.

FACILITIES: Facilities available for use at the Mansion include the Hearth Room (the lowest level), gardens and grounds, a small modern kitchenette, coat room, and two accessible restrooms.

- **The Hearth Room** can accommodate approximately 30 people for a sit down lunch or dinner and no more than 40 for a standing reception.
- **The Mansion Grounds** offer several acres of beautifully landscaped grounds. There are extensive gardens at the Mansion filled with hundreds of varieties of perennials, lilacs and roses that bloom throughout the year. The grounds around the Mansion can comfortably accommodate groups up to 100. Users typically rent a tent and use the flat area by the historic Sycamore tree, the Gazebo Garden, Upper Garden or on the parking lot.

AVAILABLE SEASONS & DAYS: The Mansion is open to the public for tours on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday from 1 – 4 p.m. The Mansion's Hearth Room is available year-round and the Grounds during warmer months. Private events and set-up times scheduled outside public tour times and other CCHS program times.
